DESCRIPTION:

Descaler is a concentrated acidic CIP bio-degradable detergent and lime scale remover for use in fermenters, beer and milk storage, and industrial dishwashing machines and equipment. Lime build-up reduces efficiency and increases energy costs for these machines and equipment. Regular use of descaler, especially in hard water areas, greatly increases efficiency.

- Removes scale build-up and iron stains.
